

The renowned firm of London Booksellers MAGGS Bros has published a number of remarkable catalogues describing books of the greatest rarity. Illustrated with numerous facsimiles and illustrations accompanied by excellent annotations, they are a valuable source of information to anyone interested in old books.

For fifteen years from 1925 onwards the catalogue entries were written by Sarah de Laredo, they remain a model of erudition, notably the catalogue of Books on Spain (q.v.)

“With a superb disregard of commercial value, Miss Laredo would do as long a note, amounting often to an essay, for a book worth two or three guineas as for one valued at several hundred.” (Catalogue of Maggs Catalogues. p.2)

The Paris branch of Maggs Bros was managed by Dr. Maurice Ettinghausen, who Palau records as being a regular visitor to Spain purchasing books to fill the catalogues published in Paris as well as London.



Among the earliest American books, of which complete copies have come down to us, the present work is the very first as regards the date of its printing.

According to the date on the title, the typesetting was finished in May 1543.

Owing to the fact that no examples of any book printed in Mexico before 1543 have been found, it is difficult to ascertain exactly the date of this book, which is the first Mexican Impression of which complete copies are known.
