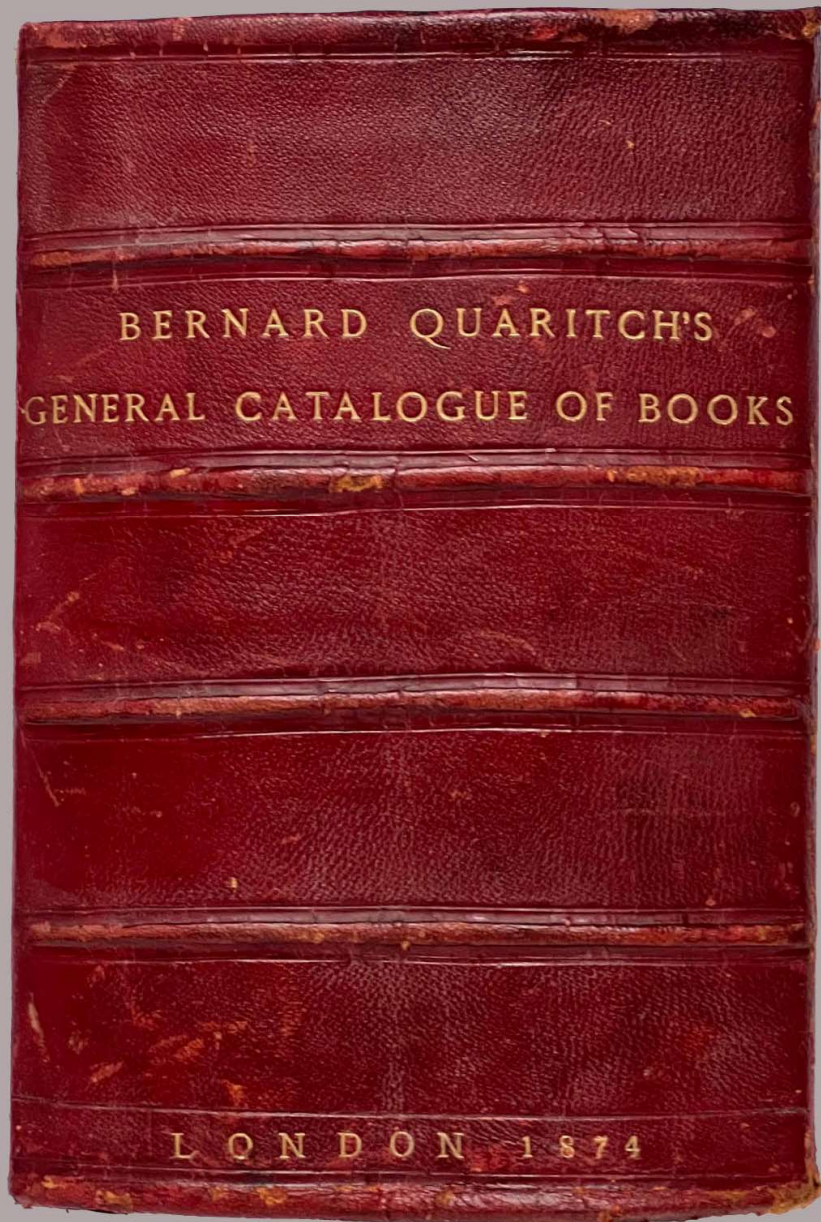

Bernard Quaritch

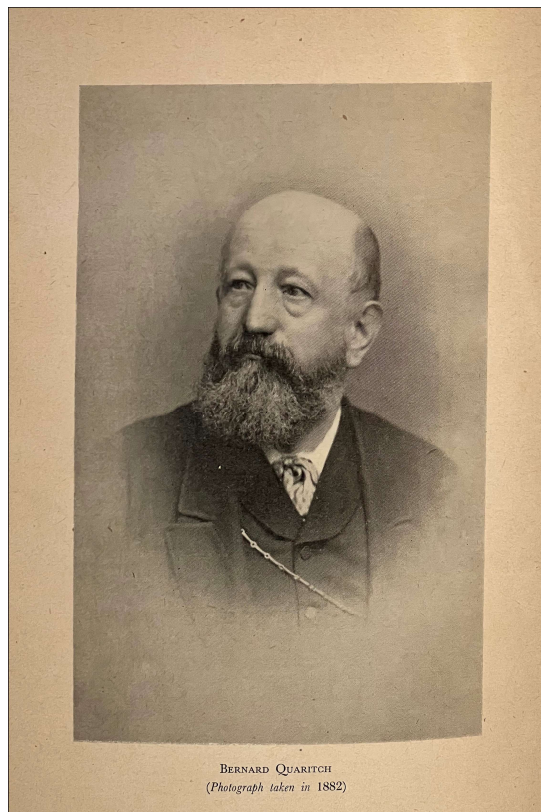
Nació en Prusia en 1819, vino a Londres en 1842.

1842 – 1847 trabajó con el librero Henry George Bohn

Al dejar de trabajar con Bohn abrió una tienda en N° 16 Castle Street, Leicester Square y publicó su primer catálogo: una hoja volante con lista de unos 100 libros. Poco a poco el negocio creció hasta alcanzar una posición dominante en el mundo de libros antiguos. Murió en 1899 dejando el negocio a su hijo Bernard Alfred Quaritch.

Born in Prussia in 1819, Bernard Quaritch came to London in 1842 where he was employed by the leading London bookseller Henry George Bohn from 1842 - 1847.

On leaving Bohn he set up his own business in N° 16 Castle Street, just off Leicester Square, and published his first catalogue: a single sheet listing some 100 titles. Over time the business grew to become the foremost bookseller in London. Following his death in 1899, the business was inherited by his son Bernard Alfred Quaritch.

El PRIMER CATALOGO de Quaritch desde N° 15 Piccadilly. Ofrece más de 6.574 libros agrupados por temas, con índice general al final; algunas fichas con breves anotaciones. Incluye secciones sobre Literatura española (pp.48 - 64), idiomas orientales, Filología y Literatura europea.

Bernard Quaritch left the firm of Henry Bohn early in 1847 and established himself in business on his own account at 16 Castle Street, Leicester Square. His first catalogue was in broadsheet form in October of 1847, it was followed by two other broadsheets. This is the first catalogue from his new premises at N° 15 Piccadilly.

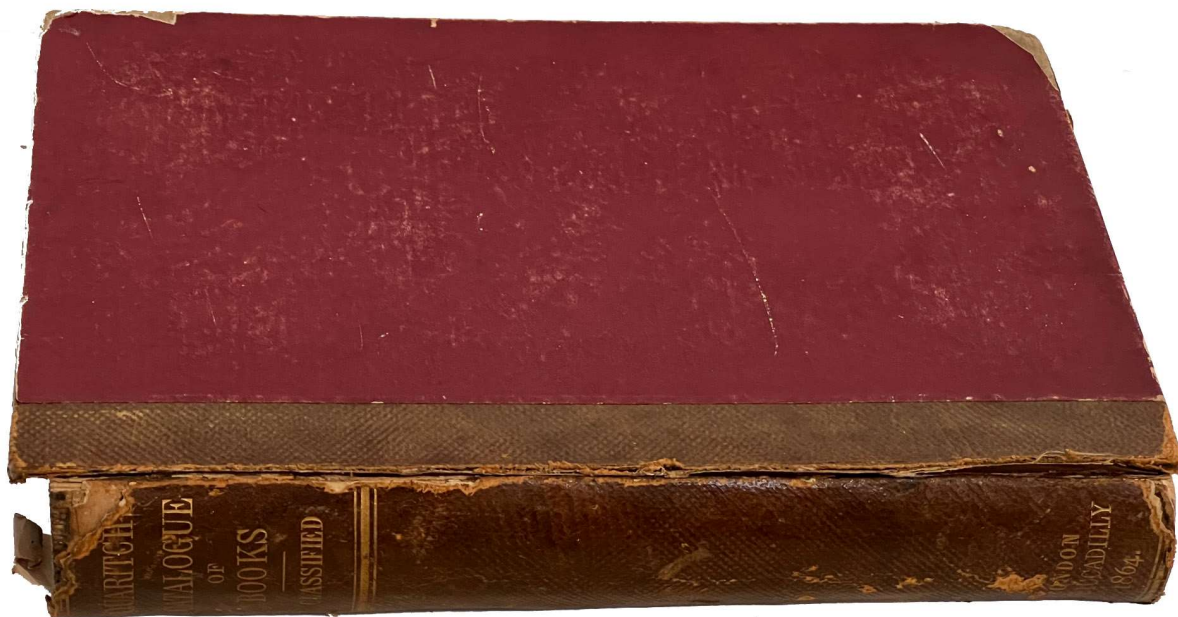

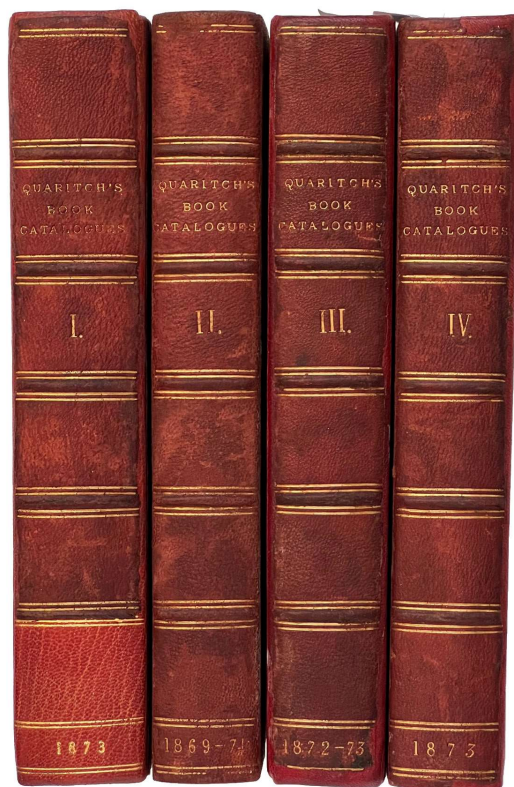

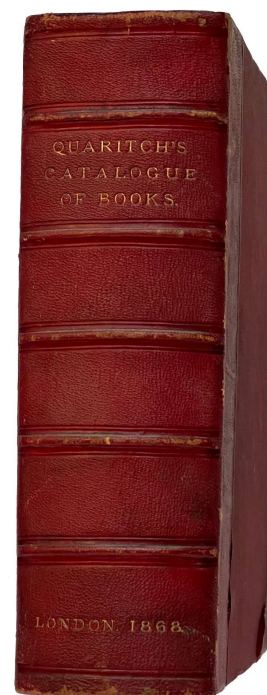

Of Manuscripts, the number is about a thousand, including early Biblical and Classical Codices from the Xth Century downwards, Illuminated Missals, Chronicles, and an extensive collection of Oriental Works." 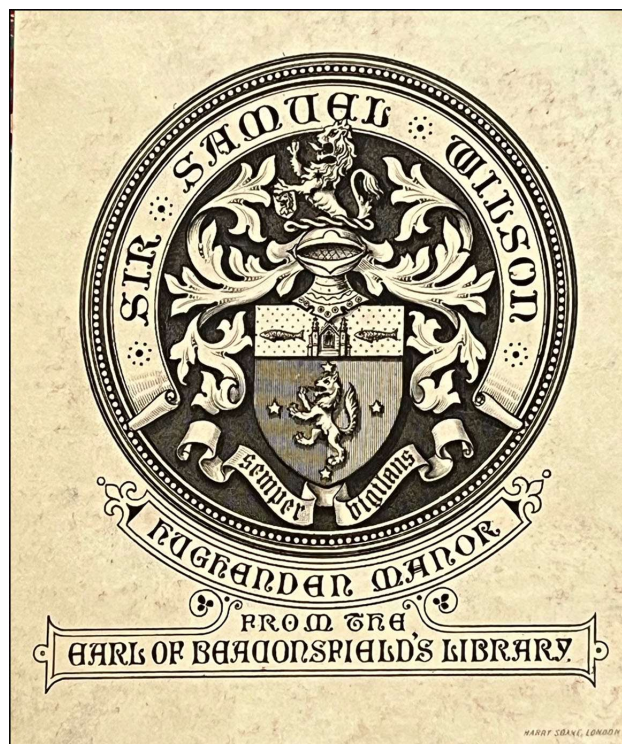
